DAY 1

Arrive in Lima where one of our representatives will be waiting to escort you to your hotel. Spend your first day exploring this vibrant city at your leisure or relaxing by the rooftop pool. Overnight at Miraflores Park, A Belmond Hotel.

DAY 2

This morning visit a local market, then continue to a restaurant where the chef will show you how to prepare our traditional dishes. DAY 5

Travel from Ollantaytambo train station to Machu Picchu aboard the Hiram Bingham, A Belmond Train. On arrival at Agua Calientes, board the bus to Machu Picchu and embark on a two-hour guided tour of the legendary citadel. Sit down to afternoon tea at Sanctuary Lodge, A Belmond Hotel before returning to Aguas Calientes to rejoin, Hiram Bingham. Return to Cusco, enjoying fine dining and live music on the way. Witness the sunrise at Lake Titicaca before sailing to the Uros floating islands. Overnight on Andean Explorer.

DAY 9

Admire Lake Lagunillas and the ancient Sumbay Cave paintings before disembarking at KM 93 for a transfer to Las Casitas, A Relmond Hotel

Head to the Condor's Cross for amazing views before exploring the charming villages of the Colca Valley. Continue to the town of Maca to learn about local life in the valley. Enjoy a tempting lunch, shaded by our beautiful trees. Then, visit our aromatic garden to learn about local herbs.
