### LIFE ON BOARD

#### CABINS

There are four categories of private cabins: Pullman Single, Pullman, State Cabin and Presidential Cabin, all offering WiFi. The former two have upper and lower berths while the latter offer two single beds at floor level. Throughout each, a warm ambience flows thanks to cherrywood and elm burr panelling, decorative marquetry and fine fabrics. All are fully air-conditioned and fitted with en-suite showers and toilets. Presidential Cabins benefit from a complimentary minibar with guests enjoying private transfers at the beginning and end of the journey.

During the day, berths and single beds are converted into seating from which guests can admire the stunning, ever-changing vistas outside.

### DINING

Pull up a seat for lunch and dinner in one of the world's most ornate Restaurant Cars. Here, internationally renowned chefs create eastern and western specialities to rival top restaurants. Expect dishes such as hoisin-glazed mackerel and lemongrass panna cotta. In the morning, a light breakfast is served in your cabin.

Alternatively, opt for a four-course Royal Celebration Breakfast, which includes traditional favourites, locally inspired dishes and a glass of crisp champagne. House wines, house spirits and local beers are included in your fare throughout the journey. Premium drinks and all drinks ordered to your cabin are offered at an additional charge.

### BOUTIQUE

For a truly unique memento of your journey, browse the train's Boutique, which offers an exclusive selection of Eastern & Oriental Express gifts.

### OBSERVATION CAR

Located at the end of the train, with its own bar, this is the perfect place to enjoy cocktails. Absorb the colonial "veranda" ambience created through teakwood flooring and panelled walls. There's also an outdoor observation area to enjoy the panoramic scenery and breathtaking sunsets. Complimentary WiFi is available for use in the Observation Car.



### SALOON CAR

This carriage contains a reading lounge, boutique and small restaurant. The reading room is a charming area offering a selection of books, magazines and games. Guests can also enjoy a 45-minute foot massage with a view here, combining both massage and traditional reflexology techniques. Foot massages can be pre-booked or organised once on board (subject to availability).

### PIANO BAR & ENTERTAINMENT

Located in the centre of the train, the Piano Bar, decorated with pale ash-wood panelling, is the social hub of the train. Open all day and late into the night for cocktails, aperitifs and liqueurs, it's where our resident pianist tickles the ivories. Local entertainment can be enjoyed on selected evenings.

### DRESS CODE

Dress for relaxed comfort as you move about the train during the day and set off on excursions. We ask that you respect local culture by wearing appropriate clothing when visiting temples. Evenings call for smart-casual attire with a touch of understated elegance, and we suggest men wear a jacket for dinner.

### KANCHANABURI AUTHENTIC EXPERIENCES

#### CLASSIC TOUR

Cruise along the Khwae Yai River aboard a local raft, taking in views of the splendid Thai teakwood houses along the banks. Your guide provides an insight into the building of the infamous railway and bridge, which were constructed by allied prisoners in World War II. After the cruise, board a coach to the Thailand-Burma Railway Centre and perhaps pay a visit to the Don Rak War Cemetery before returning to the train.

#### TRACKS TO UNSEEN THAILAND TOUR

Board a private coach to rural Nong Kao village for your hour-long bicycle tour. Cycle through the verdant rice fields, stopping for a fascinating demonstration at a local Thai farm and refreshments. Visit the Traditional Thai Wooden House for a relaxing herbal infusion before returning to the train by coach.

#### LOCAL FLAVOURS TOUR

This guided tour begins with visits to a lively wet market and an acclaimed rice noodle house, where you learn about traditional processes. You then proceed to Wat Nue Pier to board a river raft and participate in a traditional Thai cooking class on board as you sail along the River Kwai. Disembark at Chong Kai War Cemetery for an optional visit before returning to the train by coach.

### LABU KUBONG AUTHENTIC EXPERIENCES

#### TRADITIONAL VILLAGE EXPERIENCE

Embrace this chance to immerse yourself in rural Malaysian life. Villagers welcome you with a traditional martial arts dance before you sample regional food and drink and browse locally produced handicrafts. Enjoy a guided walk through the rice paddies to learn about the process of planting and harvesting before heading to a plantation where rubber, banana and durian are grown. Your tour finishes with refreshments that include banana and durian chips produced from the plantation crops.

#### HILL TREK

Your excursion begins with a visit to a banana and durian plantation. After sampling the delicious chips produced here, join your guide – an expert naturalist – to climb the peak of the nearby hill, learning about the local area as you go. Cold towels and refreshments greet your arrival at the top, alongside panoramic views over the village and surrounding rice paddies. Peer through the binoculars provided and you may even catch a glimpse of the train waiting at nearby Padang Rengas Station. Recommended for advanced walkers only.

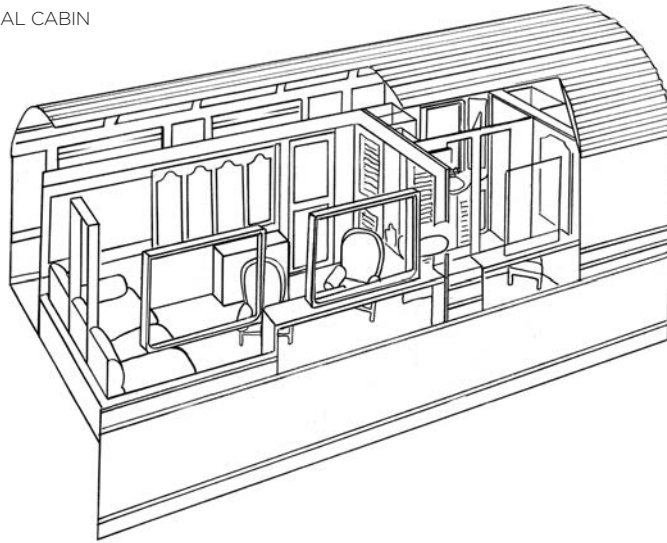
### BANGKOK

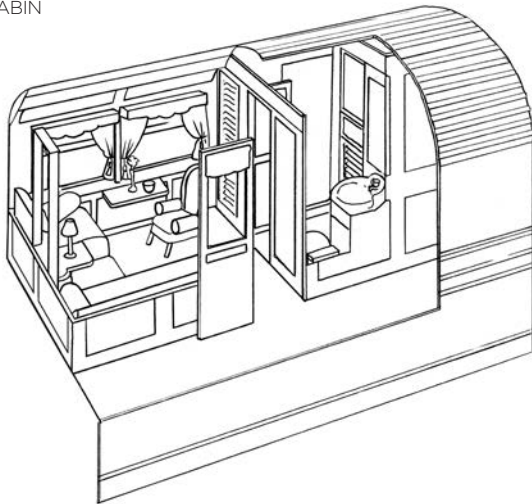

## CABIN PLANS

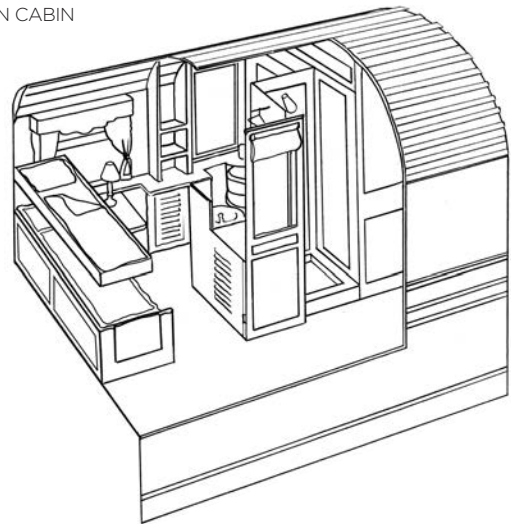
PRESIDENTIAL CABIN
