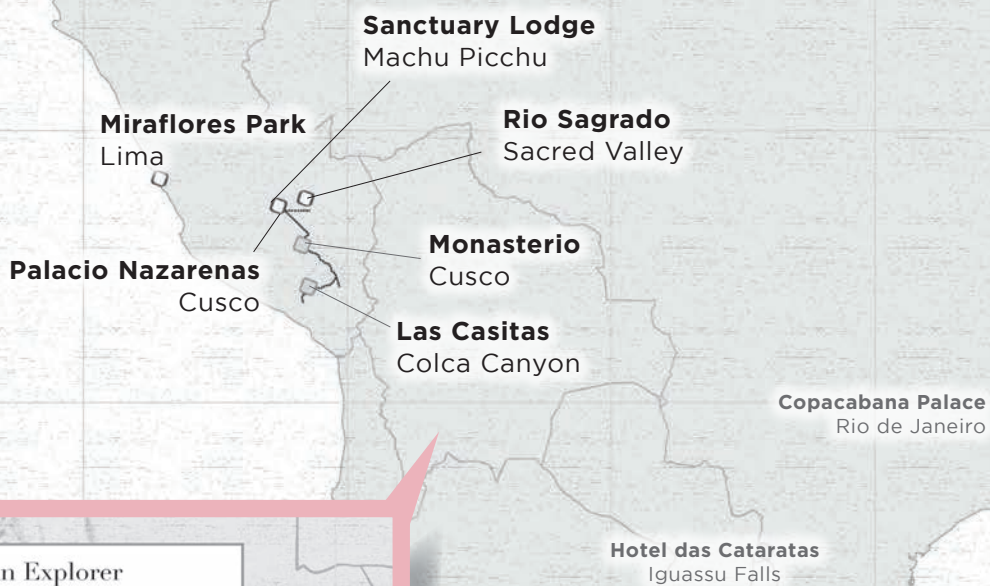

DAY 1 - FRIDAY

Arrive in Lima where one of our representatives will be waiting to escort you to your hotel. Spend your first day exploring this vibrant city at your leisure or relaxing by the rooftop pool. Overnight at Miraflores Park, A Belmond Hotel.

DAY 2 - SATURDAY

DAY 7 - THURSDAY

Board the Andean Explorer, A Belmond Train to Puno and Arequipa. Visit Raqchi. Overnight on board the train at Lake Titicaca station.

DAY 8 - FRIDAY

Witness the sunrise at Lake Titicaca before sailing to the Uros floating islands and Taquile. Overnight on Andean Explorer.

DAY 9 - SATURDAY

Admire Lake Lagunillas and the ancient Sumbay Cave paintings before ongoing to Arequipa. On arrival to Arequipa enjoy a panoramic tour as you travel to the airport. Fly to Lima. At Lima Airport you will be given assistance with your international flight connection.
