Dear Guest.

Let us take you on an extraordinary journey through one of the world's most sublime regions. The Amalfi Coast is where scenes worthy of great paintings come to life. Enchanting landscapes and hidden colours overlook the sea, inlets and idyllic coves must be seen to be believed, and lemon groves dot the coastline like beacons between Sorrento and Ravello.

In Ravello, Caruso is the dulcis in fundo – the icing on the cake – of all this beauty. Its panoramic hilltop setting points to the sky even as its slopes are caressed by the sea. Ravello is also called the 'City of Music' and Wagner's muse, where visitors are thrilled by a bird's-eye view of the bluest bay in the world.

Caruso, A Belmond Hotel, is located 5 minutes' walk from Ravello's main square, home to the Cathedral and a variety of charming shops, restaurants and bars. The two main attractions here are Villa Rufolo and Villa Cimbrone, both open to the public.

Villa Cimbrone's origins date from the 11th century, but the villa and its gardens were extensively renovated by a British nobleman, Lord Grimthorpe, in the early 20th century, with help from Vita Sackville-West. The breathtakingly beautiful gardens, with classical temples, statuary and views over the Amalfi Coast, are open to the public daily and well worth a visit.

Villa Rufolo was built by a wealthy merchant family in the 13th century. Renaissance author Boccaccio wrote about it in his 1353 collection of short stories entitled The Decameron. In its prime, the villa was one of the most glorious on the Amalfi Coast, and legends abounded of treasure hidden in the grounds. Every year it hosts the Ravello Festival, where the orchestra plays on a dramatic stage, practically suspended over the sea.

Pompeii

Highlights include the Hall of the Augustals, boasting two striking frescos of Hercules, and the beautiful floor mosaics in the bathhouses. Enjoy a half-day (4-hour) tour, travelling in a Mercedes for up 2 to passengers, for a price of Euro 400.00. A private guide is available for Euro 210.00 per 2-hour guided tour. Paestum, on the Tyrrhenian coast, is a majestic archaeological site boasting three of the world's best-preserved ancient Greek temples. It was originally called Poseidonia, in honour of the Greek god of the sea. The on-site museum houses the mysterious Tomb of the Diver and offers visitors a fascinating glimpse into the grandeur of Greek settlers' lives before the area fell under Roman control. Nearby, Tenuta Vannulo, reached by an olive-lined drive, is home to 300 buffalo, whose milk is made into prized, organic mozzarella. State-of-the-

art technology and a spa-like environment for the animals meet time-honoured production techniques, with all the cheese crafted by hand.

Buzz along the rural roads, soaking up vistas of green forest, terraced lemon and olive groves, dairy farms and rocky riverbeds, till you reach the bucolic winery, Tenuta San Francesco. Tour the cellars where the magic happens, then sit down to an inviting farmhouse lunch. Several mouthwatering courses – fresh local mozzarella,

salami, pasta with beans, eggplant parmigiana – are perfectly paired with the vineyard's signature wines. As you're taken through the complexities of labels such as the award-winning Per Eva, a blend of rare indigenous grapes, Falanghina, Pepella and Ginestra, you'll taste the love in every sip.

This small winery located in the village of Tramonti is 30 minutes away by car. It was founded by three local families determined to safeguard the last pre-phylloxera vineyards in this mountainous region. The cost of visiting the winery with lunch and a guided tasting is Euro 100.00 per person.

A chauffeur-driven car transfer by Mercedes for up to 2 people, to and from the winery, plus waiting time of up to 3 hours, costs Euro 400.00 (VAT included).

The coast

A 50-minute helicopter tour over the Gulf of Salerno (Ravello, Amalfi, Positano, Capri, Sorrento). Price starts from Euro 2900.00 (VAT included).

Ruins tour

50 minutes soaring above the fascinating ruins at Ravello, Pompeii, Vesuvius and Herculaneum. Price starts from Euro 2700.00 (VAT included).

Islands tour

Begin this enchanting walk in Piazza Duomo and head towards Villa Rufolo. On the left of the entrance gates, you will find via Annunziata, which is the first group of steps you have to take. On your right you will see the Annunziata Church, one of Ravello's major churches. Past this, you come to a paved road. Cross it to find the second flight of steps, which leads to the area of Torello. A three-minute walk will take you to San Pietro alla Costa Church, which is believed to be the first church founded in Ravello. It dates from the 10th century but has been rebuilt many times and was completely restored in the 1970s. On the way down towards the square in Torello, you have a choice of two routes to Minori.

The first is to take the wide steps of via Santa Croce to the left. You will pass under pergolas of grapes and lemons and continue past the ruins of Santa Croce Church and the cluster of buildings of Villamena with its 10th-century San Gennaro Church. Alternatively, go straight on, following the path to the square in Torello, where you find the 10th-century Church of San Michele Arcangelo. Descending the steps towards Minori and keeping right at the crossroads near a chapel, stop to admire the interesting view of Ravello. Minori nestles in a charming, peaceful bay, backed by steep, fertile slopes. Wander among its bougainvillealined streets to discover historical monuments and medieval art.



The Path of the Ants is an ancient walking trail that connects Tramonti to the nearby towns of Maiori and Minori. It winds through an area rich in lemon trees, hence the name: formichelle were women who used to carry baskets of freshly picked lemons on their heads between the groves and the seaside towns. Laden with a staggering 80kg of fruit, they would walk slowly in single file. This remained common work for women of the area until the 1970s. Today, as you stride along this breathtakingly beautiful route, passing churches, ancient villages and woodland, spare a thought for the long-suffering lemon bearers whose work was invaluable to the lives and industry of the Amalfi Coast.

Join an expert guide to learn about the history, cultivation techniques and uses of the famous "sfusato amalfitano" lemon on a trek from the green valleys of Tramonti through the lemon terraces to the coast at Minori. Suitable for all, the walk lasts around 3 hours 30 minutes and is of medium difficulty. It can be tailored to different fitness levels and interests. The cost for the tour guide is Euro 280.00 (VAT included). A chauffeur-driven transfer by Mercedes for up to 2 people, to and from the path is Euro 100.00 (VAT included) each way.

AUTENTICO WALKTHROUGH THE HERITAGE OF TRANSMIT

Discover Tramonti, one of the most authentic villages on the Amalfi Coast, where agriculture is all-important and centuries-old traditions are proudly preserved. This guided excursion takes you across the valley, passing vineyards, chestnut and lemon groves that meld into a harmony of flavours and colours. The experience begins with a short visit to a farm, where you walk among the grazing cows and watch a shepherd making mozzarella before your eyes. You can even taste it while it's still warm. Continue along the Path of the 13 Churches, which crosses the valley, and admire the ancient Tintore vineyards boasting 300-year-old vines. The

route ends at a charming farmhouse, surrounded by lemons, where you will learn how to produce the local liqueur, limoncello. The farmer will then use it to prepare a Limoncello Spritz, serving it with a delicious platter of cheeses and bruschetta. Suitable for everybody, the walk lasts around 5 hours. It can be tailored to different fitness levels and interests. The cost for the tour and tastings is Euro 320.00 (VAT included). A chauffeur-driven transfer by Mercedes for up to 2 people, to and from the path, is Euro 100.00 (VAT included) each way.



Touch paradise with your feet firmly on the ground on the Path of the Gods. Let us lead you on a spectacular hike, 500 metres above sea level, from Agerola to Nocelle, a hamlet of Positano. Follow the old communication route, which was used for centuries by the locals. Lasting around 3 hours, the 7.8km walk winds along sheer cliffs offering jaw-dropping vistas at every turn. The caves and deep inlets are unique in the world.

Your tour guide costs Euro 280.00. A chauffeurdriven car transfer by Mercedes for up to 2 people, to Bomerano, an hour from the hotel, costs Euro 165.00 (VAT included). The return journey from Positano also costs Euro 165.00 (VAT included). Alternatively, come back via our complimentary boat tour at 15:00 upon reservation.

THE FERRIERE VALEY

Plunge into a prehistoric valley, where the subtropical microclimate has created an exclusive habitat for the giant fern. Enjoy a cool, guided hike past waterfalls and rivulets through pastures and overhanging cliffs. Continue through ancient iron works and ruined paper mills, passing the cathedral en route to the sea. There are two route options: the first, starting in Campidoglio, is more panoramic, of medium difficulty, and lasts 4-5 hours. The second, starting from Pontone, is suitable for all levels and takes 3-4 hours.

Your tour guide costs Euro 280.00 (VAT included). A chauffeur-driven car transfer by Mercedes for up to 2 people, to the start of the walk, costs Euro 75.00 (VAT included). The return journey from Amalfi costs Euro 75.00 (VAT included). Alternatively, come back using our complimentary, scheduled shuttle bus.





Set off from the panoramic vantage point of Campidoglio, in Scala, 600 metres above sea level. As the first rays of sun brighten your footpath and day dawns, be spellbound by the sweeping views that embrace the entire Amalfi Coast and part of the Gulf of Salerno. Continue striding through the hamlets of Scala, immersed in lush woods, chestnut groves and lemon trees before finally reaching the beach and the sea. This excursion begins an hour before dawn, so the time varies from month to month. It lasts 3 hours. Your tour guide costs Euro 280.00 (VAT included) for 2 people. To reach the path, a round-trip chauffeur-driven car transfer by Mercedes for up to 2 people, costs Euro 75.00 (VAT included) each way.
