of the history of this marvelous city. Get ready with your camera, as he'll point out the best spots to strike a pose so you can take these wonderful memories back home.







Out and About

PEÑA DE BERNAL



Bernal, one of Mexico's most-visited Magical Towns, is dominated by a 433m high peak, the third-largest monolith in the world. Walk around it, learn about the tribes that lived here and explore the beautiful downtown area, including a museum devoted to Mexican folk masks. Later, enjoy a traditional Mexican lunch with a fabulous view. 




