Ritual MASTERCLASS PROGRAM



Create your own masterpiece with expert guidance of renowned Mexican artist Kara de Lara over the course of two immersive days.

De Lara will take you by the hand to explore the secrets of her own technique, to learn more about her experiences and her inspiration, in an intimate and close environment, where you can enter her world - real and imaginary. No painting experience is required as the artist will take you step by step along this adventure to encounter the inner nature of the artist hidden within us all.

DAY 1

10am-1pm - Morning session

Each participant will receive a project kit. Karla will explain the process of the materials to be used, and participants will do the initial tracing. The artist will guide the group through shading and highlights with liquid wax.

4pm-7pm - Afternoon session

This session will focus on color as Karla addresses the handling of colored inks and their usage in her own works. She will explain the how and why of the technique, how to apply and mix them, how to give balance to your painting, among others.

DAY 2

10am-1pm - Morning session

Once the canvases from the previous day's inking are dry, Karla will explain the process of light extraction and gloss detailing to give the pieces

4pm-7pm - Evening Session

The final stroke of the piece will commence, highlighting it with wax again, but this time solid wax to give drama and contour. The pieces will be signed and left to be lacquered so that they are protected and properly finished.

During the development of the four sessions, Karla will ease any doubts or hesitations. Through the lens of her incredible works, she will open a dialog about the process of creating original art, the construction of a work, balance and form, how and why she developed her unique technique, among other topics.
