APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

We are looking for artists that can integrate tactile craft elements such as ceramics, painting, or sculpture into their work, ensuring a connection to the legacy that defines La Residencia and Deià. The residency provides a sanctuary for creative exploration and the opportunity to push the boundaries of artistic practice, inspired by the infinite possibilities of the horizon.

A key aspect of the residency is the artist's engagement with the hotel life, including meaningful interactions with its guests. Through conversations and exchanges with visitors, artists may find new sources of inspiration, enriching their work while broadening their horizons even further.

HOW TO APPLY

Artists must submit the following documents. Please note that incomplete applications or those that do not meet the requirements will be disregarded.

- Copy of a Valid ID: Passport or identity card.
- CV: Including solo and group shows, projects, residencies, and publications.
- Portfolio: Maximum 10MB.
- Motivational Letter: Maximum 1,000 words.
- Project Proposal: Including a description of the ideal outcome and collaborative activities proposal to interact with hotel guests, maximum 1,000 words.

RESIDENCY DETAILS

Selected artists will enjoy the following benefits:

- Accommodation: Artists will be housed at La Residencia or nearby.
- Monthly Living Grant: €500 per artist.
- Production Grant: €5,000 per artist.
- Working space: Artists will have full access to the hotel's art studio filled with natural light.

This setup encourages interactions, shared experiences, and collaborative activities with hotel guests. Additionally, artists may offer remunerated art classes to hotel guests with a creative calling.
