SIURELL PAINTING

APRIL 20 5:00 PM - KID'S CLUB Learn to decorate siurells, Mallorca's traditional whistling figurines. Intrinsic to the island's rich cultural heritage, the craft behind these ceramic artworks has been handed down through generations of artisan families. The siurell's origins are something of a mystery. Some believe they date from Etruscan times, others think they were brought to the island by Phoenician traders. Whimsically decorated with splashes of green and red, the oven-baked, lime-whitened figures are said to have been a source of inspiration to Joan Miró, whose own enchanting artworks can be admired in our Restaurante Miró.
