He enlisted celebrated architect Michele Busiri Vici to design the hotel, a sanctuary of white, organically curved buildings that blended seamlessly into the landscape while framing views of the turquoise waters beyond.

Widely considered one of Busiri Vici's masterpieces, Romazzino is, to this day, a haven as welcoming to families enjoying their villeggiatura as to the international jet set mooring their superyachts at nearby Porto Cervo.

Beyond Romazzino's own fragrant gardens and private white-sand beach, Sardinia offers a wealth of treasures and attractions. Watersports lovers are spoilt for choice in the warm Mediterranean Sea, enjoying sailing adventures to hidden beaches and nearby Corsica, as well as snorkelling and paddleboarding in the crystalline waters. Cyclists and trekkers can discover spectacular coves, majestic forests and spellbinding views, while inland there are ancient nuraghe ruins, bohemian hamlets and family-run vineyards to explore.

a Maddalena Archipelago National Park is one of the most seductive regions in the world. White, sandy beaches fringed by luxuriant vegetation, unspoilt waters teeming with sea life, and rugged granite rocks eroded and shaped by the elements come together to create a marine paradise.

Islands and islets located in this protected stretch of water between the Strait of Bonifacio and the Costa Smeralda include La Maddalena, Caprera, Santo Stefano, Spargi, Budelli, Santa Maria and Razzoli, as well as countless holms, such as Mortorio, Soffi and Nibani. All await sublime exploration.

Departure point: Board a tender service from Romazzino pier. Optional stop at La Maddalena island to visit the historic centre. Pause in the beautiful bays of Spargi, Budelli, Caprera and Cala Coticcio for a dip in the clear, turquoise waters.

Lunch: Two options – a picnic lunch box, prepared by the hotel restaurant and enjoyed on board in a beautiful mooring, or lunch in a renowned restaurant only accessible by boat.

Times: Depart from the port at 10:00 and return at 18:00. Included: Skipper, water on board and entrance to the protected marine park of La Maddalena.



B eyond the Bonifacio Strait, close to Corsica, lies the idyllic Lavezzi archipelago, a cluster of granite islets with quiet beaches lapped by turquoise waters. This cruise lets you first explore Bonifacio, the spectacular medieval town at the tip of Corsica, before sailing to escapist bliss.

Departure: Board a tender service from Romazzino pier. Sail along the Maddalena archipelago, passing the islands of Santa Stefano and Spargi to reach Bonifacio. Alight for a relaxed visit to Bonifacio with its towering limestone cliffs, medieval citadel, picturesque port and inviting shops. Stop at various beaches on request, including the stunning Isola Piana and Lavezzi islands.

Lunch: Options – a picnic lunch box, prepared by the hotel restaurant and enjoyed on board in a beautiful mooring, or lunch in a celebrated Bonifacio restaurant or charming trattoria.

Times: Depart from the port at 10:00 and return at 18:00.

TAVOLARA AND MOLARA

iscover a protected sanctuary with a wealth of different characteristics.

Rising out of the sea off the northeast Sardinian coast is Tavolara, a dramatic island surrounded by crystalclear waters. Here, fine sands meet limestone and granite mountains and wild nature meets panoramic views. The protected waters encircling the island are perfect for sailing and for admiring the unique landscape of bays and coves between Punta Ceraso and Punta l'Isuledda. The area also includes the pristine islands of Molara and Molarotto, rich in biodiversity and ideal bases for diving and snorkelling.

Departure: Board a tender service from Romazzino pier. Stop in the beautiful bays of Tavolara, Piscine di Molara, Cala Moresca, Coda Cavallo and Mortorio.

Lunch: Two options – a picnic lunch box, prepared by the hotel restaurant and enjoyed on board in a beautiful mooring, or lunch in a restaurant on Tavolara island.

Times: Depart from the port at 10:00 and return at 18:00.



PEVERO HEALTH TRAIL

tride out on a glorious trek through untamed nature on a beguiling trail with some enchanting surprises.

The Pevero Health Trail is located just a few steps from the hotel, between Pevero and Romazzino bays, and winds around Monti Zoppu. Starting from our lobby, you can enjoy a walk tailored to your interests and fitness levels.

The full trail is 13km long, meandering through Mediterranean scrub to reach spectacular bays and solitary beaches. It is easy in many areas, slightly more challenging in others. Along the way there are gems to discover, from ruined farmhouses that speak of an ancient lifestyle to spiritual surprises, such as a wooden statue of Madonna dello Speronello. There are also 11 exercise stations along the route, hence the trail's name.

Difficulty: Easy - medium Duration: 1,5 to 2 hours





he island of Tavolara is a majestic limestone massif that rises dramatically out of the sea to a height of 565 metres.

This pearl of Gallura is one of the most spectacular sights in the whole of the Mediterranean region. Appearing like a mountain fallen from the sky, it remains forever suspended between the blue sea and the white clouds.


Your excursion begins at the hotel pier. Board the boat and sail to Tavolara island. If the vessel is a comfortable and sporty large Zodiac, the journey will take about 60 minutes. Alight to explore the island – different treks can be recommended to suit varying levels of fitness.

On your return, stop at Molara island to capture incredible panoramic pictures.

Optional: lunch at a tavern on Tavolara or a picnic on the island's summit.

ap into your thrill-seeking side with a canyoning adventure along the Rio Pitrisconi. Tackle the granite massif of Monte Nieddu, whose peak soars 970 metres above sea level. Immersed in a mountain environment of rocky peaks, rugged ridges and tumbling waterfalls, discover the pristine nature of Sardinia.

Accompanied by expert adventure instructors, prepare to navigate a canyon course of spectacular cascades, natural pools and water slides (toboga) that will make your day uniquely exhilarating.

It is also possible to dive from different heights in total safety under the watchful eye of the instructors.


ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES

Archaeological Park of Arzachena, where eight extraordinary archaeological sites unveil remnants from 6,000 years of Sardinian history.

Green valleys and granite geology set a captivating scene for monuments such as the Li Muri necropolis, the stunning 'Prisgiona' nuraghe and the Giant tombs showing that Arzachena's civilisation dates from the Neolithic period.

From this era until the Bronze Age, when the first Nuraghi (watchtowers) and the Tombs of the Giants were built, around 2,500 years passed. Discover what happened in the interim centuries through enthralling stories and facts relayed by the park's expert guides.
